Required Junior Seminar

(3 credits)

HIS 3051 Junior Seminar: Approaches to History

Covers methods, theories, and practices used by historians. Topics vary. Required for majors before enrolling in HIS 4935. Prerequisite: History major standing.

Required Senior Seminar

HIS 4935 Senior Seminar

(3 credits)

A seminar to be taken by all History majors, to provide experience in research, writing, and critical analysis. Prerequisite: HIS 3051.
